 India gets its first Centre for Wetland Conservation and Management: A dedicated Centre for Wetland Conservation and Management (CWCM) has been established at the National Centre for Sustainable Coastal Management (NCSCM), Chennai, and an institution under the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.

- Union Finance Minister, Nirmala Sitharaman is presenting the Union Budget 2021 for the 3rd time in a row. The Union Budget is the yearly financial report estimating the income and expenditure presented to outline future policies to be adopted by the government for sustainable growth and development.
- The Economic Survey 2020-21 was released on 29th January 2021 by the Chief Economic Advisor of India, Krishnamurthy Subramanian. According to the survey, India's economy could contract 7.7 per cent in the financial year that ends on March 31.

- PNB restricts withdraw of money from non-EMV ATMs has decided to restrict its customers from withdrawing money from non-EMV automated

Teller Machines (ATMs) with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> Feb, 2021. To overcome this, PNB will introduce OTP based systems for withdrawing cash.

- In the last bi-monthly monetary policy meet for the current, the Reserve Bank of India projected India's GDP growth rate at 10.5 per cent for the fiscal year 2021-22. The growth outlook has improved significantly, and the vaccination drive will further boost the economic rebound.
- Federal Bank has announced the launch of "FedFirst", a special savings account scheme for children below 18 years of age.

#### DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL MARKETS

• Amazon.com Inc founder and CEO, Jeff Bezos has announced that he would step down as CEO of the company and become Executive Chairman in Q3 of 2021, i.e. with effect from July 01, 2021. Andy Jassy, who is currently serving as the chief executive of Amazon Web Services (AWS), will replace Bezos as CEO of Amazon. Bezos started the company 27 years ago, on 5 July 1994, as an internet bookseller.

- India's position has slipped by two places to be placed at 53rd spot in the 2020 Democracy Index, from among 167 countries.
- The state-owned aerospace and Defence Company, Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Hyderabad-based Mishra Dhatu Nigam Limited (MIDHANI) for development and production of composite raw materials for use in aerospace.

- The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) has announced that it is preparing low-cost satellite launch vehicles costing around 30-35 crores each. These low-cost launch vehicles can put into orbit satellites weighing 500 kgs.
- ISRO Director: K.Sivan; Headquarters: Bengaluru; Established: 1969.
- The AN-32 aircraft of Indian Air Force powered with 10% blend of bio-jet fuel took off and landed successfully in Leh airport.
- The International team of astronomers led by scientists at the University of California, United States (US) have discovered an Ultra massive monster galaxy dubbed as XMM-2599.
- The Northern Coalfields Ltd (NCL) has established a research and development centre, named 'Science and Applied Research Alliance and Support (SARAS)'.
- Engineering college students in Hubballi, Karnataka have come up with 'Maya', a robot that has been programmed to serve in banks and speak in many regional languages. With the help of artificial intelligence, it recognises customers' faces and responds to them by using a Chabot. After the banking hours, it automatically goes to the docking yard and charges its batteries without the help of any human being.
- A 25-year-old Kashmiri woman, Ayesha Aziz, has become the youngest female pilot in the country. She became the youngest student pilot to get a license at the age of 15 in 2011. The 25 -year-old from Kashmir who is the youngest female pilot in the country acts is a source of inspiration and a beacon of empowerment for numerous Kashmiri women.
- The Union Ministry of Finance has notified 'Printing of One Rupee Currency Notes Rules,

- 2020' vide Gazzette Notification G.S.R. 95(E) dated February 7, 2020.
- The first of its kind 'amputee clinic' in India, has been launched by the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), a premier medical and research institution in Chandigarh. The basic intent of this initiative is to bring an Amputee as a near-normal functional human being in society.

- India to include the Asian Elephant and the Great Indian Bustard in the list of species that merit heightened conservation measures.
