DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT

- •The e-commerce company Flipkart has partnered with ICICI Lombard to offer its customers the 'Group Safe-Guard' insurance, a group health insurance policy. The 'Group Safe-Guard' comes with daily cash benefits starting from Rs 500, and 'Hospicash' benefit for Flipkart consumers.
- •Tata Motors Limited has appointed Marc Llistosella as its new Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and Managing Director (MD). The appointment of Llistosella will be effective from July 1, 2021.

DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND FINANCE

- •The Union Cabinet approved a Rs 12,195-crore Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for domestic manufacturing of telecom and networking products such as switches, routers, radio access network, wireless equipment and other IoT access devices.
- •The global forecasting firm Oxford Economics has revised India's economic growth projection for the Calendar year 2021 to 10.2 per cent, compared to a previous estimate of 8.8 per cent.
- •National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has announced that UPI AutoPay has now gone live on Gaana. Its integration with UPI AutoPay has made Gaana the 1st player in the Media & Entertainment

Industry to roll out the innovative e mandate feature on UPI. The introduction of UPI AutoPay will empower Gaana's users to experience a smooth and seamless mechanism of renewing their subscriptions.

DEPARTMENT OF BANKING AND INSURANCE

- ICICI Bank has announced the launch of a Common Payment Card System (CPCS) in partnership with the Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) and Chennai Smart City Limited (CSCL) to provide citizens with a one-stop solution for making various kinds of payments.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has constituted an eight-member expert committee on Primary (Urban) Co-operative Banks (UCBs) to examine issues and suggest a road map for strengthening the sector. The committee will be chaired by the former RBI Deputy Governor N. S. Vishwanathan.

DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL MARKETS

- The government has extended the deadline for filing annual goods and service tax (GST) return and reconciliation statements for FY20 till March-end, from existing date of February 28.
- India's fiscal deficit widened to Rs 12.3 lakh crore in January, representing 66.8% of the target as per the revised estimates (RE) for FY21, according to data from the Controller General of Accounts, released on

Friday. The figure showed a sharp improvement from 132% of the earlier deficit target in December, as finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman more than doubled the target to Rs18.5 lakh crore or 9.5% of gross domestic product from Rs 7.96 lakh crore.

- Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) has signed a Statement of Intent with Greenstat Hydroge India Pvt. Ltd., a subsidiary of Greenstat Norway to set up a Centre of Excellence on Hydrogen.
- India and Ethiopia signed two agreements related to visa facilitation and leather technology. The Ethiopia Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister, Demeke Mekonnen Hassen is on a 4-day visit to India to hold useful and productive discussions on a range of bilateral and regional issues.




- 23RD FEBUARY, 2021- Vegan Online Webinar Virtual Tour Of Keynote Speaker Kuntal Joisher.

- •Indian astronomers have reported one of the strongest flares from a feeding supermassive black hole or blazar called BL Lacertae, analysis of which can help trace the mass of the black hole and the source of this emission, the Department of Science and Technology said.
- •An IIT Madras-Incubated start-up Pi Beam Electric has recently launched a sustainable electric two- wheeler, dubbed as PiMo. The utility e-bike has been developed for personal and commercial use. It does not require a licence or registration
